Websites Webbingcy builds for private events

Last updated: 2 August 2026

1. About this policy

Webbingcy builds and runs websites for private events — **weddings, christenings and parties**. Each site belongs to the people hosting that event, who we call **the hosts**.

The hosts decide what the site asks for and why. Webbingcy runs the site and handles the information on their instructions, and never uses it for its own purposes. In data-protection terms, the hosts are the controller and Webbingcy is their processor.

This policy explains what happens to information collected through an event site. It does not cover webbingcy.com itself, or anything the hosts do with your information away from the site.

2. What we collect

When you RSVP

Only what the hosts have chosen to ask. Depending on the event, that may include:

- your name;
- your email address, your phone number, or both;
- whether you are coming, and how many adults and children with you;
- which parts of the event you plan to attend;
- dietary requirements or allergies, where the form asks (see section 3);
- any message you choose to write;
- the date and time you submitted; where the form asks you to agree before sending, that is also recorded as when you gave your consent.

Nothing is collected until you submit the form, and only the fields marked required have to be filled in.

If the site has a photo album

The photos or videos you upload, and their file names.

If the site has a seat finder

The name you type in, so we can find your table. The match happens on our server and the name you typed is not stored.

If the hosts send invitations by SMS

Your phone number — given to us by the hosts. We do not collect it from you.

Automatically

Ordinary web-server logs: IP address, browser, and which pages were requested. We keep these to keep the site secure and working.

We use no analytics and no advertising trackers, and we add no third-party fonts of our own — the typefaces you see are served from our own servers. reCAPTCHA (below) does fetch one font file from Google as part of how it works.

3. Dietary requirements and allergies

Where a form asks about dietary requirements or allergies, what you write may say something about your health. Please give only what the hosts need in order to feed you safely — there is no need to name a medical condition. It goes to the hosts and their caterer and is used for nothing else — the one exception being that the hosts can choose to include it in a message they send you, which would pass it to the SMS provider named in section 4.

4. Who your information goes to

- **The hosts.** Everything you submit is for them — that is the point of the form.
- **Google.** RSVP replies are stored in a private Google Sheet. Google reCAPTCHA checks that submissions are not automated — its use is covered by [Google's privacy policy](#) and [terms of service](#). Photos and videos may be stored in Google Drive.
- **Vonage.** Where the hosts send SMS invitations, your phone number is passed to Vonage to deliver the message — along with anything the hosts' message itself includes, such as your name.
- **Our hosting provider,** which stores the site and its server logs.

We do not sell your information, and we share it with no one else unless the law requires us to.

Google and Vonage operate outside Cyprus and the EEA. Where your information reaches them, that transfer relies on the standard contractual terms in their agreements with us.

5. How long we keep it

RSVP replies, uploaded photos and videos, and any SMS lists are kept until **12 months after the event**, and then deleted. Server logs are kept for a shorter period. The hosts can ask us to delete anything sooner, and we will.

6. Your rights

You can ask to:

- see what is held about you;
- have it corrected;
- have it deleted;
- withdraw your consent, at any time;

- object to how it is used, or ask us to restrict that use;
- receive a copy in a portable form.

Because the hosts decide what happens to the information, asking them directly is usually quickest. You can also write to us at privacy@webbingcy.com and we will pass the request on and help them answer it.

If you are not satisfied, you can complain to the Office of the Commissioner for Personal Data Protection in Cyprus.

7. Children

These sites often celebrate a child, and RSVP forms often ask how many children are coming. We do not knowingly collect information directly from children. Where a child's details appear, an adult has provided them when replying on their behalf.

8. Security

Submissions travel over an encrypted connection, and forms are protected by reCAPTCHA. The Google Sheet, any Drive folder and the admin tools are private, and reachable only by the hosts and by Webbingcy staff who need access. No system is completely secure, and we cannot promise absolute security.

9. Changes to this policy

We may update this policy. The version linked in the footer of the site is always the current one, and the date at the top tells you when it last changed.
